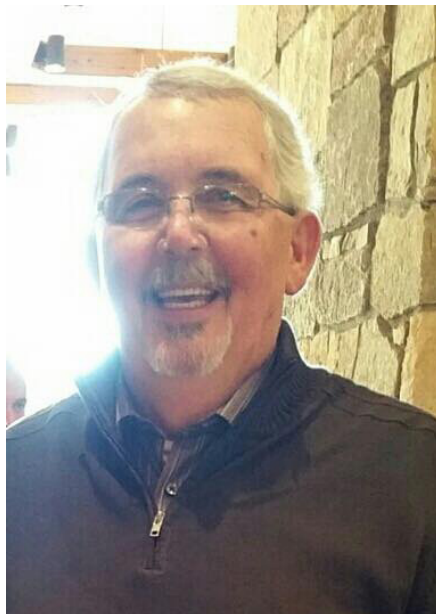


# TEAMSTERS LOCAL 710 REMEMBERS
